

ORDINANCE NO. 6-2015

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE PARTIAL AMENDMENT, SUPPLEMENTATION AND REVISION OF SECTION 11A-12, "CONSTRUCTION OFFICIAL" IN CHAPTER 11A, ENTITLED "FLOOD DAMAGE PREVENTION" OF THE "REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF MORRIS PLAINS, NEW JERSEY, 1972" TO RENAME THIS SECTION AS "ADMINISTRATION AND TO DESIGNATE AN NFIP FLOODPLAIN ADMINISTRATOR.

**WHEREAS,** the Borough Council is desirous of amending Chapter 11A to designate a National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) Floodplain Administrator.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED,** by the Borough Council of the Borough of Morris Plains, they being the Governing Body thereof, as follows:

**Section 1:**

Section 11A-12, presently entitled "Construction Official" in Chapter 11A, "Flood Damage Prevention" of The Revised Ordinances of the Borough of Morris Plains, New Jersey, 1972" (hereinafter "Revised Ordinances or "Revision") is hereby amended, supplemented, revised and renamed as "Administration" and with a new subparagraph designating the Borough Engineer as the NFIP Floodplain Administrator so that hereafter, Section 11A-12 shall read, in its entirety, as follows:

**11A-12. Administration.**

(a) The Construction Official is hereby appointed to administer and implement this chapter by granting or denying development permit applications in accordance with its provisions.

(b) The Borough Engineer is hereby designated as the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) Floodplain Administrator (FPA).

**Section 2:**

All other provisions of the aforesaid Chapter 11A of the Revised Ordinances shall be unaffected and are hereby continued.

**Section 3:**

All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

**Section 4:**

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be invalid by a Court of competent jurisdiction, such a decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

**Section 5:**

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication.
