

ORDINANCE NO. 8- 2015

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE \$71,000.00 FROM THE CAPITAL FUND BALANCE FOR EQUIPMENT AND UPGRADES FOR THE POLICE AND FIRE DEPARTMENTS TO BE UNDERTAKEN BY THE BOROUGH OF MORRIS PLAINS, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Morris Plains, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1: *Equipment and upgrades to be authorized are as follows:*

<u>Improvement or Purpose</u>	<u>Estimated Cost</u>
<i>Upgrade to LiveScan fingerprint computer, new patrol laptop computers and additional updates to security system for Police Department</i>	<i>\$50,000.00</i>
<i>Purchase of additional vehicle rescue equipment and upgrades to Fire Department vehicles and attachments</i>	<i>\$21,000.00</i>

Section 2: *This total amount of \$71,000.00 for the said improvements is hereby appropriated from the Capital Fund Balance.*

Section 3: *Said acquisition is lawful capital purchase of the Borough having a period of usefulness of at least five (5) years.*

Section 4: *This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage after publication thereof in accordance with law.*
