The Magic of Reading

This program is for children grades K – 4 (or those reading at 4th grade level or below). It is designed to help the children who encounter difficulties with literacy or those who want to gain confidence in their existing skills. This program meets the **State Curriculum Standards** by incorporating standards in both fiction and non-fiction.

The class boasts a positive environment for children to read confidently with teachers and mentors as coaches. Reading strategies will be emphasized according to student's current reading abilities as follows: a) reading strategies-word attack, b) basic comprehension - locating information in text, c) fluency in oral reading, d) drawing conclusions, e) making connections to text, and producing oral responses to questions. Children will leave each class with an index card indicating books read, skills worked on, or new vocabulary learned.
