

ORDINANCE NO. 7-2021

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE \$125,000.00 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE VARIOUS IMPROVEMENTS IN AND BY THE BOROUGH OF MORRIS PLAINS, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

***BE IT ORDAINED**, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Morris Plains, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:*

Section 1: Improvements to be authorized are as follows:

<u>Improvement or Purpose</u>	<u>Estimated Cost</u>
<i>Purchase of 5 sets of Morning Pride Turnout gear and 20 portable two way radios with two rapid rate 6 unit chargers and programming software for the Borough of Morris Plains fire department</i>	\$ 63,000.00
<i>Improvement of municipally-owned buildings and facilities in and by the Borough, including the Community Parks with the upgrade of Bleachers, installation of two hundred and eight lineal feet of 6' high privacy fencing at the Franklin Place Lot, security cameras and fobs at the Municipal Building and installation of an outdoor canopy at the Fire Department at the Municipal Building</i>	\$ 62,000.00

Section 2: This aggregate sum of \$125,000.00 for the said improvements is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund.

Section 3: Said improvement is a lawful capital purpose of the Borough of Morris Plains having a period of usefulness of at least five (5) years.

Section 4: This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage after publication thereof in accordance with law.
