

ORDINANCE NO. 6-2022

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE \$410,000.00 FROM THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND FOR THE VARIOUS IMPROVEMENTS IN AND BY THE BOROUGH OF MORRIS PLAINS, IN THE COUNTY OF MORRIS, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Morris Plains, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1: *Improvements to be authorized are as follows:*

<u>Improvement or Purpose</u>	<u>Estimated Cost</u>
<i>Acquisition by purchase of new and additional vehicular equipment for use by the Department of Public Works including two (2) dump bodies, one (1) z-turn mower, and one (1) leaf loader with attachment together with all accessories and equipment necessary therefor or incidental thereto</i>	\$272,400.00
<i>Purchase of mobile radio to be installed in the F-150 chief 1 vehicle and 10 portable two way radios with two rapid rate 6 unit chargers and programming software for the Borough of Morris Plains Fire department</i>	\$ 32,800.00
<i>Purchase of Borough cameras & ALPR (Automatic License Plate Readers) for the Borough of Morris Plains Police department</i>	\$ 56,600.00
<i>Improvement of municipally-owned buildings and facilities in and by the Borough, including the installation of Fire department doors and replacement of Garbage cans and Planters along Speedwell Avenue.</i>	\$ 48,200.00

Section 2: *This aggregate sum of \$410,000.00 for the said improvements is hereby appropriated from the Capital Improvement Fund.*

Section 3: *Said improvement is a lawful capital purpose of the Borough of Morris Plains having a period of usefulness of at least five (5) years.*

Section 4: *This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage after publication thereof in accordance with law.*
