

ORDINANCE NO. 16 - 2022

AN ORDINANCE TO APPROPRIATE \$168,750.00 TO ENHANCE PEDESTRIAN SAFETY IN THE BOROUGH OF MORRIS PLAINS AND PROVIDING THAT THE SUM OF \$135,000.00 TO BE RECEIVED FROM NEW JERSEY DOT GRANT WITH \$33,750.00 APPROPRIATED FROM CAPITAL FUND BALANCE

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Morris Plains, in the County of Morris, State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1: *Improvements to be authorized are as follows:*

<u>Improvement or Purpose</u>	<u>Estimated Cost</u>
<i>Enhancement of Pedestrian safety (e.g. New sidewalks, new crosswalks, traffic calming, intersection improvement)</i>	\$168,750.00

Section 2: *This total amount of \$168,750.00 for the said improvements is hereby appropriated, said sum being inclusive of all appropriations heretofore made therefor and including the sum of \$33,750.00 from Capital Fund Balance and including also the sum of \$135,000.00 received or expected to be received by the Borough from the New Jersey Department of Transportation as a grant-in-aid of financing said improvement or purpose.*

Section 3: *Said improvement is a lawful capital purchase of the Borough having a period of usefulness of at least five (5) years.*

Section 4: *This ordinance shall take effect upon final passage after publication thereof in accordance with law.*
