ORDINANCE NO. 8-2026

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE PARTIAL AMENDMENT OF SECTION 18-2 "DEPARTMENT ESTABLISHED" IN CHAPTER 18, "POLICE DEPARTMENT," OF THE "REVISED ORDINANCES OF THE BOROUGH OF MORRIS PLAINS, NEW JERSEY, 1972" BY INCREASING THE NUMBER OF SERGEANTS WITHIN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM FIVE TO SIX SERGEANTS.

WHEREAS, the Borough Council of the Borough of Morris Plains is desirous of amending Chapter 18, Police Department in the "Revised Ordinances of the Borough of Morris Plains, New Jersey, 1972" by increasing the number of Sergeants within the Borough's Police Department to from five (5) to (6) Sergeants for which the Borough has been advised by the Chief of Police that such an increase is necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Borough Council of the Borough of Morris Plains, they being the Governing Body thereof, as follows:

Section 1:

Section 18-2, Department established as set forth in Chapter 18, Police Department, of the aforesaid Revised Ordinances is hereby amended, supplemented and revised by increasing the maximum authorized number of Sergeants in the Department from 5 to 6, so that hereafter, the maximum number of Sergeants authorized by Section 18-2 shall read:

<u>Title of Position</u>	<u>Authorized Number of Personnel</u>
Sergeant	6

Section 2:

All other provisions of the aforesaid Section 18-2 and Chapter 18, Police Department, of the Revised Ordinances shall be unaffected and are hereby continued.

Section 3:

All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4:

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is, for any reason, held to be invalid by Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such a decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this Ordinances.

Section 5:

This Ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication in accordance with law.
